- T-Mobile Access Increase in WNC
 - o "T-mobile is bringing SatCOLT (satellite cell on light trucks) to Asheville. These SatCOLTs provide cellular voice and data, along with Wi-Fi (so people can use Wi-Fi calling no matter their carrier).
 - Our crews have overcome extremely challenging conditions and limited site access to restore 132 sites and position 149 portable generators in the last 24 hours and their work will continue today. In addition to the SatCOLT in Hendersonville, we've activated another at the Tractor Supply Co. in Asheville and are working to place others at the Mission Hospital in Asheville, the Cherokee County Emergency Operations Center (EOC) in Murphy and in Cherokee to support the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians."

Find Missing Person(s)

General WNC

- NC Residents call NC211 (non-residents call 1-888-892-1162) to report a missing person or request a welfare check, press 1 once you are connected to reach an operator. Have all information available (name, location, health conditions, etc.) to complete the request. Call volumes are high, but operators are processing requests as quickly as possible. (NC Emergency Management)
- Call 1-800-RED-CROSS (1-800-733-2767) if you are unable to locate a friend or family member and that person:
 - Has a serious, pre-existing health, mental health condition or Functional and Access Need.
 - o Is a member of the military-connected community (active duty, reserve, guard, retiree, veteran, or immediate family member).
 - Or you shared the same residence within the disaster impact area, or have recently been in contact with someone (within the past year) but are unable to reach them because of the disaster.

 - Will connect you with volunteers from local relief organizations, community groups and faith communities who may be able to assist with muck out, trees, tarp, and debris. Volunteers will bring the tools and equipment necessary to complete the work.
 - All services are free, but service is not guaranteed due to the overwhelming need. The hotline cannot assist with social services such as food, clothing, shelter, insurance, or questions about FEMA registration.
- Per Buncombe County Briefing (Sunday, 9/29): <u>Transfer Station at Hominy</u> <u>Creek</u> is closed and collections put on hold.

FEMA Guidance

- Maintain documentation of debris clean-up. This can be pictures of debris prior to clean-up efforts and post clean-up efforts.
- Separate debris into 5 piles, as applicable:
 - o Construction Debris (i.e. drywall, building materials, carpet, etc.)
 - Vegetative Debris (i.e. limbs, branches, plants, etc.)
 - Large appliances
 - Hazardous waste (i.e. oil, cleaning supplies, etc.)
 - Electronics
- Place debris curbside. If your street experienced any wash-outs, and a ditch was formed next to the curb, do not place debris inside the ditch. Rather, place debris as close to the curb as possible.



By County:

Watauga County (updated 9/29 2:10pm)

- Beginning 9/2/9, "SDR" trucks will be in Watauga county. SDR is a debris removal company that specializes in disaster removal, and has contracted its service to Watauga County and the Town of Boone to assist with cleanup.
- Residents should follow FEMA Guidance.
- Watauga County's landfill and convenience stations will be closed the week of October 1st. Individual community members will not be able to access the Watauga County landfill.
