



# Hawaiian Islands Local Storm Resources

## Quick Prep Checklist

### Personal:

- Water: 1 gallon per person per day (more if breastfeeding, sick, or for pets).
- Food: Ready-to-eat items (manual can opener), baby formula as needed.
- Medications: 7-day supply, copies of prescriptions, medical devices/chargers.
- Warmth: Layers, hats/gloves, blankets/sleeping bags, hand/foot warmers.
- Light/power: Flashlights (not candles), extra batteries, power banks, car charger.
- Safety: First-aid kit, whistle, multi-tool, duct tape, matches/lighter.
- Sanitation: Wipes, trash bags, toilet supplies.
- Documents and cash: IDs, insurance, important papers in a waterproof bag; small bills.

### Checklist for storm/flood/wind damage:

If you're in or near impacted areas (North Shore O'ahu, Maui, or Big Island threat area):

1. **Follow official evacuation orders** (County Emergency Management / Civil Defense). ([dod.hawaii.gov](http://dod.hawaii.gov))
2. **Avoid floodwater** (do not drive through water; roadbeds can be washed out). 211's disaster pages emphasize that flooding can be sudden and dangerous. ([auw211.org](http://auw211.org))
3. **Stay away from downed power lines** and damaged structures; call 911 if immediate hazard.
4. **Use 211** for updated shelter/food/road-closure information and to reduce load on 911 for non-emergencies. ([hicares.hawaii.gov](http://hicares.hawaii.gov))

5. If you need a safe place: go to a **Red Cross open shelter** (meals + charging often available)
